



A GREAT OPPORTUNITY TO RECEIVE MONEY TOWARD YOUR COLLEGE EDUCATION!

To be eligible for any of these scholarships, the applicant (or a member of the applicant's immediate family) must be a member of Golden Valley Electric Assn. and receive electric power from GVEA at his/her principal residence.

- **\$16,000 Academic Degree Scholarship - One to be Awarded**

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior. In addition, applicant must be pursuing a four-year Bachelor Degree at the University of Alaska and have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.5.

- **\$3,500 Academic Scholarships - Three to be Awarded**

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior. In addition, applicant must be pursuing a four-year Bachelor Degree at an accredited university and have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0.

- **\$3,000 Continuing Education Scholarships - Three to be Awarded**

Note: Current year graduating high school seniors are not eligible for this scholarship. Applicant must be enrolled or accepted as a part-time (at least 6 credit-hours per semester or 4 credit-hours per quarter) or a full-time student at an accredited school in a program leading toward a Bachelor or Master's Degree. Applicant must have completed 12 or more credits with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

- **\$3,500 Career and Technical Education Scholarship - One to be Awarded**

Applicant must be enrolled or accepted as a part-time (at least six credit hours per semester or four hours per quarter) or full-time student at an accredited school in a two year or shorter program leading toward a recognized license, certificate, Associates, or lower level degree. Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 at the most recent educational institution attended (high school or post-secondary).
